**The school library is essential to every long-term strategy for literacy, education, information provision and economic, social and cultural development. As the responsibility of local, regional and national authorities, it must be supported by specific legislation and policies.**

**School Libraries must have adequate and sustained funding for trained staff, materials, technologies and facilities. They must be free of charge.”**
