- Immersion Learning Assistance Grant: reading collection (level book), French computer program, laptops and projector, CD collection (en action)
- Library Immersion Grant: French library books (fiction and non-fiction), French magazines (periodicals), \$1,000 for lending library at secondary level.
- Immersion Revitalization Grant: Text books (non-fiction sciences and social studies)
- Teacher In-service: teacher travel and teacher on call costs to attend French conference in Vancouver
- Core French Supply: French units, reproduction materials, posters,
- Immersion Supply: reading strategies poster in French, teacher resources, French books, classroom supplies, French sticker books and bookmarks, listening centre.
- Immersion Growth: teacher resources, classroom collections
- Socio-Cultural Grant: visit by a French author, Carnival activities, transportation to attend French performances at the local performing arts centre, targeted contributions to bi-annual secondary school Quebec exchange trip
- Learning Resources Grant: French music (cd's), classroom resources (dictionaries, verb books, reproduction materials), book collections (readers for primary grades), Science 10 targeted texts, topped up texts for secondary social studies

**2 How did these expenditures support the acquisition of Core French as a second language?**

All of the resources helped teachers to deliver the Core French curriculum and supported them with specific activities. It made the Core French classes alive and full of French flavour. Novels were purchased at the secondary level upon recommendation by a French exchange student attending the French immersion secondary school.

**3 How did these expenditures support the acquisition of French Immersion as a second language?**

All of the material was used in classrooms by teachers and students to support their French learning. It helped students to increase their vocabulary and knowledge of the French language. It also supported teachers by offering them current print material particularly with non-fiction. It also allowed us to provide special activities rich in French culture. Allowed schools to update learning resources and
