Teacher Salaries, July 1, 2007

The following report shows minimum and maximum teacher salaries for categories 4, 5, 5+, and 6, as at July 1, 2007. Salaries reflect gains resulting from the 2006 grid harmonization effective April 1, 2006, and 2.5% increase to all salary grids effective July 1, 2006 and 2.5% effective July 1, 2007.

There will be an additional 2.5% increase to all grids and categories in 2008. Also in 2008, a second harmonization process will result in a 2.5 to 3.0% increase to all category 4, 5, 5+, and 6 maximum salaries. All grids and categories will receive a 2.5% increase in 2009 and a 2.0% increase in 2010. The provincial collective agreement will expire June 30, 2011.

Salary increases effective:

July 1, 2006	2.5%
July 1, 2007	2.5%
July 1, 2008	2.5%
July 1, 2008	2.5% to 3.0% at maximum for categories 4, 5, 5+, and 6
July 1, 2009	2.5%
June 30, 2010	2.0%

In addition to salary increases, teachers will receive 2% of salary in lieu of salary indemnity plan (SIP) premium each year. This amount will be paid as a taxable benefit and thus will be included in pension calculations.

Table 1 shows the minimum and maximum salaries as at July 1, 2007 for Categories 4, 5, 5+, and 6.
