We are seeking an individual who is interested in on-call maintenance work with the BCTF to assist with janitorial services, building, and furniture maintenance.

Examples of janitorial duties include floor cleaning and waxing; vacuuming of carpets and upholstery; dusting and cleaning of furniture, windows, walls, carpets, and upholstery; cleaning, sanitizing, and stocking of washrooms; light gardening, pressure washing, leaf blowing, and litter pick-up.

Examples of furniture maintenance include shelf installations; furniture moves and assembly; and equipment assembly.

Examples of building maintenance duties include painting; small plumbing, carpentry, and tile repairs; wood refinishing; light bulb changes; baseboard installations; door repairs and replacement.

**Required qualifications**

- excellent communication skills
- ability to work independently and as part of a team
- training and/or experience in painting, carpentry, and plumbing
- minimum of two years' experience in custodial and/or maintenance work preferably in a building with an automated security system
- ability to do heavy lifting
- secondary school graduation
- flexibility and willingness to accept assignments on short notice.

Building Maintenance Worker Certification is desirable.
